Unfinished and New Business

- **Activity Groups/Standards Development**

- The **RIST** project was launched to address the lack of compatibility between devices from different manufacturers being used to provide live, low-latency contribution quality video via the Internet. To date, TR-06-1 covering RIST Simple Profile and TR-06-2 Main Profile have been fully released and adopted by multiple vendors. A set of RIST interoperability levels has also been defined and published as the TR-06-2 RIST Levels Annex. TR-06-3 (RIST Advanced Profile), first released in 2021, provides a protected tunneling mode that can carry any legacy protocol, including RTP-based media signals such as SMPTE ST 2110, ST 2022 and MPEG TS over UDP. In addition, bidirectional protocols based on TCP can be transported securely and reliably in the same packet tunnel while consuming only a single UDP port to simplify firewall configuration. It was revised in 2022 to include a reference to the EAP SHA256-SRP6a Authentication Protocol, which is documented in Annex D of TR-06-2:2022.. TR-06-4 Part 1 (Source Adaptation) released in 2022, defines a protocol for a stream receiver to report current network conditions to a stream sender. Based on this information, the stream sender can dynamically adapt to varying network conditions, either by changing the routing or changing the bit rate. Work continues within the group towards developing the Advanced profile of the RIST specifications that includes a flexible secure tunneling protocol plus additional features and capabilities.

- **Activity Groups/Standards Development Continued:**

- **Ground-Cloud-Cloud-Ground (GCCG)**. This activity group will collect and organize user requirements and work towards establishing a common technical approach such that multi-vendor interoperability is possible. This group will operate under the IPR guidelines of the Video Services Forum. The specific tasks of this group are detailed in the Activity Group Authorization Form. Co-Chairs: John Mailhot-Imagine Communications and Andy Rayner – Nevion

-**Internet Protocol Media Experience (IPMX)** Activity Group. This activity group is working on a set of Technical Recommendations to enable the carriage of compressed and uncompressed video, audio and data over IP networks for the ProAV market. The IPMX series of Technical Recommendations will be published as TR-10. This group will operate under the IPR guidelines of the Video Services Forum. The specific tasks of this group are detailed in the Activity Group Authorization Form. Co-Chairs: Jack Douglass-PacketStorm and Jean Lapierre-Matrox

 - ST 2110 (10, 20, 21 & 30) Standards for Professional Media Over Managed IP Networks, Published Sept. 18, 2017
 - The ST 2110 Emmy award was shared between SMPTE & VSF
